Hi Gang - A big **Thank You** to those who were able to attend. I thought the meeting and discussion went well and I am excited to have a plan in place for next year.

For everyone's review, I am attaching the document I handed out. This document outlines the meeting dates and responsibilities for next year. The bottom of the document highlights changes to the structure of the meeting. These items are a guide but the sponsoring den(s) and pack committee will need to work closely together on the final details for each monthly meeting.
